

## LOCAL RULES

1. Out of Bounds (OB) is indicated by white stakes. OB is staked left of water on #7, #8, #14 (partial), #15 and #17.
2. Lateral Water Hazards are indicated by red stakes or extreme rough (grass longer than the rough cut grass adjacent to fairways, tees & greens).
3. Rock walls next to ponds lie within the Lateral Water Hazard - no free relief is provided.
4. Free drops must be taken in the following locations:
  - at staked trees (including stakes, wires & trees)
  - in planting beds except those in hazards
  - on cart path surfaces
  - adjacent to wood rail fences (free relief is permitted if swing is obstructed)Free Drop Procedure: determine nearest relief, plus one club length no closer to hole.
5. Safety netting, poles and guy wires - line of play relief is permitted (See Rule 24-2 of the RCGA Rule Book).
6. **NO PLAY IS ALLOWED FROM NATURAL HABITAT AREAS.** If a ball is in a Natural Habitat Area, or it is virtually certain that a ball has not been found next to this area, relief is provided in accordance to the drop rules of a Lateral Water Hazard.
7. Water Hazard Drop Zones are provided on #14, #15 and #18. Water Hazard Drop Zone Procedure - proceed to drop zones for relief from initial shots entering hazard subject to one shot penalty.

### NOTES:

1. All yardage indicators provide measurements to the center of green.
2. Flag stick positions on greens - red front, white middle, blue back.

## COURSE ETIQUETTE

- Please replace divots, repair all ball marks on greens, rake all sandtrap footprints and leave rakes in bunkers.
- Power and pull carts shall not enter Natural Habitat Areas and extreme roughs.
- Power carts shall not be on turf within 30 feet of green edges.
- Please respect all directional signs.
- Power carts shall stay on paths and fairway crossings unless fairway access is expressly permitted by the Pro Shop Staff.
- Respect your fellow players by keeping pace with the group ahead of you at all times.
- Play without delay and allow faster players to play through.
- Please report all contact of golf balls with outside property or pedestrians of bordering trails or streets to the Pro Shop Staff.
- You are responsible for the eventualities of your golf shot.
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your tee times.

## DRESS CODE

Golfers are required to dress in proper attire. Improper attire includes denim jeans, cutt-offs, tee shirts, tank tops and hard spike shoes. This is not a complete list. Please direct questions regarding proper golf attire to Pro Shop Staff.
